TABLINGS

I, James Jim Skosana, the Chief Whip of the Majority Party, hereby table a Notice of Motion in terms of Rule 84(1)(b) that at the next sitting of Monday, the 25th of February 2019, I shall move that the House –

1. notes that section 109(1) of the Constitution, 1996, provides that the Premier of a Province must dissolve the provincial legislature if the legislature has adopted a resolution to dissolve with a supporting vote of a majority of its members;
2. further notes that in terms of section 108(4) of the Constitution, a provincial legislature remains competent to function from the time it is dissolved or its term expires, until the day before the first day of polling for the next legislature;
3. acknowledges the President's announcement on 7 February 2019, that the general elections will take place on 8 May 2019; and

This House Resolves:

4. to dissolve the Mpumalanga Provincial Legislature in terms of section 109(1) of the Constitution; and
5. to suspend Rule 180 of our Rules and Orders to prevent Bills and other Legislature business from lapsing when the House is dissolved.
